Marc Brackett, Ph.D., is an Associate Research Scientist in the Department of Psychology at Yale University. He also is the Deputy Director of Yale's Health, Emotion, and Behavior Laboratory and Head of the Emotional Intelligence Unit in the Edward Ziegler Center in Child Development and Social Policy.

Dr. Brackett is the author, co-author, or editor of more than 50 scholarly publications, including four educational curricula. His current research focuses on measuring emotional intelligence; links between emotional intelligence and relationship quality, well-being, and academic/work performance; and testing whether emotion-based skills training can improve people's personal and professional lives.
