**Camulos Foundation Awards Grant to Stamford Public Schools  
To Expand Office of Family Engagement**

The Stamford Public Schools will receive \$150,000 over two years from the Camulos Foundation to expand the Office of Family Engagement. The OFE will be responsible for registering students, ensuring children are assigned appropriate services within the school district, and providing parent education and outreach.

From the moment families register their children in the OFE's centralized, one-stop location, they will also have access to a wide range of family engagement and education programs – initiatives designed to promote the achievement of all students through positive school-family-community partnerships.

“I greatly appreciate the Camulos Foundation's ongoing investment in the Stamford Public Schools, which began with a grant for our Middle School Think Tank and now will include the Office of Family Engagement,” said Superintendent of Schools Dr. Joshua Starr. “The Camulos Foundation's generous support will enable us to expand our existing efforts to offer families a comprehensive, customer-friendly introduction to the district that can be sustained throughout students' educational careers in Stamford.”

According to Deborah Brennan, President of the Camulos Foundation, “We hope it will allow for the development of a program that will improve the lives of students and their families”.

The Stamford Public School district is the fifth-largest in Connecticut with more than 15,000 students.

The Camulos Foundation was established by the partners of Camulos Capital LP, a successful Connecticut-based hedge fund, to provide a means of giving back to the communities in which its employees live and work.
