Resolution 05-08-08:122a

**BE IT RESOLVED** that beginning in the 2008 – 2009 school year, the Board of Education of Stamford Public Schools will operate according to Scenario 2, Option 2A as outlined at the Public Hearing of May 5, 2008. As per this scenario, the Board of Education will close the International School at Rogers Magnet (“Rogers”) and open the Interdistrict Environmental Magnet School (“EMS”) in September, 2009. Current staff and students at Rogers will move to EMS in September 2009. Most of the current district for Rogers will become the preference zone for EMS. Students moving over from Rogers to EMS will not be guaranteed admission into the 6<sup>th</sup> grade at EMS beginning in 2010.

Resolution 05-08-08:122b

**BE IT RESOLVED** that beginning in the 2008 – 2009 school year, the Board of Education of Stamford Public Schools will operate according to Scenario 2, Option 2B as outlined at the Public Hearing of May 5, 2008. As per this scenario, the Board of Education will close Rogers and open EMS in September, 2009. Current staff and students at Rogers will move to EMS in September 2009. All of the current district for Rogers will become the preference zone for EMS. Students moving over from Rogers to EMS will be guaranteed admission into the 6<sup>th</sup> grade at EMS beginning in 2010.

Resolution 05-08-08:122c

**BE IT RESOLVED** that beginning in the 2008 – 2009 school year, the Board of Education of Stamford Public Schools will operate according to Scenario 4, Option 4A as outlined at the Public Hearing of May 5, 2008. As per this scenario, the Board of Education will close Toquam Elementary School (“Toquam”) and open EMS in September, 2009. Current Toquam magnet students will return to their districted schools in September 2009, and current Toquam district students will be redistricted.

Resolution 05-08-08:122d

**BE IT RESOLVED** that beginning in the 2008 – 2009 school year, the Board of Education of Stamford Public Schools will operate according to Scenario 4, Option 4B as outlined at the Public Hearing of May 5, 2008. As per this scenario, the Board of Education will close Toquam and open EMS in September, 2009. Current staff and students of Toquam will move to EMS in September 2009 and not be enrolled in the environmental magnet program.

Resolution 05-08-08:122e

**BE IT RESOLVED** that beginning in the 2008 – 2009 school year, the Board of Education of Stamford Public Schools will operate according to Scenario 4, Option 4C as outlined at the Public Hearing of May 5, 2008. As per this scenario, the Board of Education will close Toquam and open EMS in September, 2009. Current students of Toquam will move to EMS in September 2009 and be enrolled in the environmental magnet program.

Resolution 05-08-08:122f

**BE IT RESOLVED** that beginning in the 2008 – 2009 school year, the Board of Education of Stamford Public Schools will operate according to Scenario 5, Option 5A as outlined at the Public Hearing of May 5, 2008. As per this scenario, in September 2009 the Board of Education will relocate Toquam staff and students in grades K through 2 to Stark School (“Stark”) and redistrict approximately 100 students out of Stark. In September 2010, Toquam staff and students in grades 4 and 5 will relocate to Stark School.
