

MINUTES OF REDISTRICTING
COMMUNITY MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
Stamford, Connecticut
January 3, 2008

The Redistricting Community Meeting of the Board of Education was held on January 3, 2008 at the Government Center, 888 Washington Boulevard. The meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Ms. Nabel, Chairperson, with the following Committee members present: Mr. Freedman, Ms. McManus, Ms. Nabel, and Mr. Rubino. Also present: Ms. Lahiri-Hoherchak, Ms. Laurie, Ms. Lorenti, and 75 members of the public.

Ms. Nabel reviewed the Redistricting Committee's Guidelines and Criteria for the Redistricting process. The members of the Committee answered questions regarding fiscal and facilities numbers.

The Committee also discussed its rationale and parameters for examining school closing.

At 9:00 p.m., members of the public divided into small groups to question and converse with members of the Redistricting Committee and other members of the BOE who were present.

Ms. Nabel reconvened the large group at 9:45 p.m. and collected notes from various tables. She reminded members of the public to attend the Public Hearing at Cloonan Middle School on January 8th.

Mr. Freedman moved, seconded by Ms. McManus to adjourn the meeting at 9:55 p.m. with the following Committee members voting in favor: Mr. Freedman, Ms. McManus, Ms. Nabel, and Mr. Rubino.
