

Impact of Proposed Reductions to Special Education Services and Student Support Services



- NO change to the Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) program
- NO change to Pre-K programs and services
- NO reduction to OT or PT services
- Special Education teacher to student ratio will change from an average of 1:10.1 (current) to 1:11.2 (proposed)
- District-based Related Service Staff schedules will be restructured to decrease emergency response, professional development and collaboration in order to cover service hours
